Marsh Haven Nature Center is located at the north end of the famous Horicon Marsh, just 3.5 miles east of Waupun, Wisconsin on Highway 49. Our all-volunteer, community supported center features displays and exhibits that help depict the history and wildlife of Horicon Marsh.

Marsh Haven Nature Center offers unique environmental education programs with a focus on experiential, hands-on learning. We base our programming on the philosophy of place-based learning and the resources of Richard Louv, author of *Last Child in the Woods* and *The Nature Principle*; Jon Young, tracker and founder of the Wilderness Awareness School; and principles from the Art of Mentoring and Coyote Teaching.

Volunteers run our center and it is open to the public during the week from noon - 4 p.m., and 9 a.m. to 5 p.m. on weekends April through mid-November.
